

2018 DR. SUBHASH C. VERMA YOUNG INVESTIGATOR'S AWARD TERMS OF REFERENCE

THE AWARD

FUNDING OF THE AWARD

The Dr. Subhash C. Verma Young Investigator's Award was established in 2006 by the Heart & Stroke/Richard Lewar Centre of Excellence in Cardiovascular Research (HSRLCE). It is funded by the family of the late Dr. S. C. Verma. The award recognizes exceptional achievement in the cardiovascular sciences and consists of:

- 1. An award of \$1,500 with no restriction of use;
- 2. A plague to commemorate the event; and
- 3. An invitation to deliver a lecture at April 11, 2018 HSRLCE's Michael J. Sole Annual Cardiovascular Scientific Day.

ELIGIBILITY, CONTINUITY & CRITERIA

Eligibility:

- 1. The nominee's research should have been conducted while they were a junior faculty member at the University of Toronto (most likely but not limited to Assistant Professor)
- 2. The nominee must be a member of the HSRLCE (see list of members)
- 3. The nominee must have been an independent Principal Investigators for no longer than seven years.

Continuity: A member can only receive the award once in his/her career.

Evaluation Criteria: The main selection criterion is outstanding contribution to the advancement of research.

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM THE LAUREATE

In order to receive the award, the laureate is required to give a lecture at the April 11, 2018 HSRLCE Annual Michael J. Sole Annual Cardiovascular Scientific Day.

THE SELECTION COMMITTEE

NOMINATION AND WINNER SELECTION

Nominations will be solicited each year from the members of the HSRLCE. Nomination deadline for the 2018 competition is Friday, February 9, 2018.

HSRLCE's Operations Committee will evaluate the nominees and select the winner.
